# Firefighter I

(Fire Department)

An employee in this class's work involves specialized firefighting responsibilities. Incumbent is a member of a fire fighting company and performs assigned tasks in the plan to fight fires. Employees may be responsible for the safe and efficient operation of firefighting apparatus. A large portion of an employee's time is spent in studying and maintaining the apparatus and in cleaning and maintaining quarters. Work is performed in accordance with a well-defined routine, and supervision is received from departmental superiors.

## Minimum Experience and Training

Graduation from an accredited high school or GED and some experience in firefighting techniques or any equivalent combination of experience and training.

## Special Requirements

Certification as a North Carolina Emergency Medical Technician, including recognizing life-threatening physical conditions and providing life support;

Certification as a North Carolina Fire and Rescue Commission Fire Fighter;

Successful completion of NIMS (National Incident Management System Courses) IS 700, IS 800, ICS 100;

Must possess a safe driving record and obtain a Class B driver's license issued by the State of North Carolina within 90 days of hire date;

Must establish and maintain residency within thirty (30) minutes of fire stations within 90 days of completion of probation.

Incumbent will be required to adhere to the "on-call" practices and procedures followed by the Fire Department.

## Physical Requirements

Must be able to perform heavy work exerting up to 100 pounds of force occasionally, and/or up to 50 pounds of force frequently, and/or up to 20 pounds of force constantly to move objects. Must be able to work at heights and in confined spaces. Works outdoors in varying weather conditions.
