### Laboratory Technician

**(Water Quality)**

An employee in this class is responsible for making a variety of examinations and tests on samples of water and wastewater at various stages of treatment and in interpretation of results. Standard procedures are used in making analyses and test results are compared with established standards to determine adequacy of treatment. Worker exercises independent judgment within the framework of accepted professional techniques and works under the general supervision of the Water Quality Manager. Work is evaluated in conference and by inspections and is reviewed through reports to determine quality of work performed.

**Qualifications:** Graduation from a four-year college or university preferably in a science-related field, or graduation from an accredited two-year college program, supplemented by advanced training in chemistry and bacteriology. Experience in laboratory testing or any equivalent combination of experience and training.

**Physical Requirements:** Must be able to lift 50 to 75 pounds. Use of microscope. Exposed to pathogens, chemicals, fumes, noise, and odors. Will work outdoors in varying weather conditions.

**Special Requirements:** Possession of a valid North Carolina driver's license.
