**Asheboro Police Arrest Woman for
Attempting to Obtain Property by False Pretenses**

ASHEBORO - On May 28th, 2014 APD detectives arrested Kristal Auman Reeder for attempting to obtain property by false pretenses. Ms. Reeder is alleged to have tried to sell advertising for a local business that would appear in a publication at a later date. The owner of the business felt like this might be a scam and after an investigation by APD personnel, it was determined that there was no publication and that Ms. Reeder was trying to acquire \$235 from the business without providing any service in return. She is in the Randolph County Jail under a \$40,000.00 secured bond for this offense as well as 3 more counts of Obtaining Property by False Pretense out of Guilford County. If any other business owners in Asheboro have purchased advertising from Ms. Reeder, contact the Asheboro Police Department to ensure it is legitimate.
