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At 6:00 p.m. on Tuesday, October 8, 2024, the Asheboro City Council will convene for a special meeting in the council chamber at Asheboro City Hall, 146 N. Church Street, Asheboro, NC 27203. During this special meeting, pursuant to Section 143-318.11(a)(6) of the North Carolina General Statutes, the Asheboro City Council will enter into closed session to consider the qualifications of potential candidates for appointment as city manager.

After the current city manager announced his retirement plans, the city contracted with the Piedmont Triad Regional Council ("PTRC") for assistance in recruiting candidates to serve as the next city manager. During the closed session, a PTRC representative will provide the city council with information about the applicants identified through the city manager recruitment process. The governing board will then consider the next steps in evaluating the candidates for appointment.

During this meeting, no final decision on the appointment of the next city manager is anticipated. The only open session meeting agenda items will be the convening of the special meeting, action on a motion to go into closed session, and the adjournment of the meeting.

This amended special meeting notice is issued on this the 1st day of October, 2024, and supersedes the special meeting notice issued on September 30, 2024.
