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On Tuesday, November 19, 2024, at 8:55 a.m., the Asheboro City Council will reconvene a special meeting at the Martha Luck Comer Conference Center on the Asheboro campus of Randolph Community College. The recessed meeting was initially called to order as a properly noticed special meeting on Monday, November 18, 2024.

The purpose of the special meeting that began on November the 18th was to enable the city council to interview a group of applicants for the city manager position. The interviews were conducted in closed session pursuant to Section 143-318.11(a)(6) of the North Carolina General Statutes.

More time is needed for the governing board to complete the scheduled interviews. Consequently, the city council voted in open session on November the 18th to recess the special meeting until 8:55 a.m. on Tuesday, November 19, 2024. At that time, the recessed meeting will be reconvened at the same location (the Martha Luck Comer Conference Center) to finish in closed session the scheduled applicant interviews.

No final appointment decision will be made during the continued special meeting. The only open session meeting agenda items will be calling the meeting to order and acting on motions to go into closed session and adjourn.
