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At 5:30 p.m. on Tuesday, August 5, 2025, the Asheboro City Council will convene for a special meeting in the council chamber on the 2nd floor of Asheboro City Hall, 146 N. Church Street, Asheboro, NC 27203. This meeting has been called for the purpose of allowing the Asheboro City Council to go into closed session for two separate purposes authorized by Section 143-318.11 of the North Carolina General Statutes.

The first closed session discussion will be held in accordance with G.S. 143-318.11(a)(4) to address matters relating to the location or expansion of industries or other businesses in the area served by the municipal corporation. The second closed session discussion will be held in accordance with G.S. 143-318.11(a)(3) to consult with the city attorney about two existing lawsuits.

The city was named as a respondent, along with the City of Greensboro and the City of Reidsville, in a petition for judicial review filed by the North Carolina Department of Environmental Quality, Division of Water Resources. In a separate civil action, the city was named as a defendant, along with Indorama Ventures USA, LLC and Starpet Inc., in a lawsuit filed by Cape Fear River Watch and Haw River Assembly.

The only agenda items planned for the meeting's open session are the convening of the special meeting, action on a motion to go into closed session, and the adjournment of the meeting. All other discussions will be conducted in closed session. No final action on any issue is anticipated during this meeting.
