



REQUIREMENTS FOR ALL IRRIGATION SYSTEMS

All applicants for City of Asheboro water service for irrigation purposes must possess a plumbing permit from the Building Inspections Department before applying for a water connection permit from the city's Engineering Department.

State law, in conjunction with the North Carolina Plumbing Code, requires residential and commercial irrigation systems to be equipped with approved backflow prevention devices. Such a device must be installed before any other connections are made and is required to be certified and periodically tested.

Work must be performed by a licensed contractor and an inspection must be scheduled and passed by Inspections Department staff to complete the permit process. The domestic water supply and irrigation system cannot be interconnected at any point and must be installed to a separate meter.
